


ANNUAL REPORT

We have had a greater impact on more lives due to the generosity of our community. We use your donation to **take action** by providing financial assistance to those in breast cancer treatment. As breast cancer incidence continues to rise and the pandemic ensues, we serve the everincreasing number of those needing financial assistance in Black Hawk County and Northeast lowa.

In 2022 we assisted 105 individuals in Black Hawk and 9 surrounding counties with \$111,248.02 towards medical bills and/or essential living expenses. We experienced a dramatic increase in the need for gas cards for those traveling to Waterloo for treatment. Even with health insurance, the deductibles and copays are overwhelming and continue throughout their extended treatment. **Your** donations stay local to make a real difference.

MAKE A DIFFERENCE





Every Beyond Pink TEAM member can **make a difference** by donating their time and talents. You can do that, too, by joining the Beyond Pink TEAM as a member or an event volunteer. If you have had breast cancer, join one of our support groups and make a difference by supporting newly diagnosed women as well as yourself. Our monthly *Touch of Courage* breast cancer support group makes the Hearts of Hope pillows for post-surgical patients. Our quarterly BPT *All Cancer Support Group* is for women with any type of cancer.

In 2022 we were able to raise our maximum financial assistance for individuals in treatment. Many applying did not have gas money for all of the trips required for treatment. Also, hospital deductibles increased for many. We had 6% more requests for assistance and awarded 15% more in 2022.

Because we receive no government funding, we rely on donations of all sizes. You can make a difference with your donation or by organizing a fundraiser. Fundraising events can be anything from casual dress days in the office, pink events at businesses, schools, and sports teams, financial grants through charitable foundations, or supporting the annual Pink Ribbon Run.

Fundraisers and Volunteers Make it Work

The Beyond Pink TEAM is successful due to the generosity of every donor and every volunteer member. Your donations and fundraisers, both large and small, have allowed us to assist 895 individuals in NE Iowa with medical bills and/or essential living expenses, totaling \$746,949.83 since 2012. Our BPT members volunteer countless hours with additional volunteers helping with events like the Pink Ribbon Run.
